## ALS UNITED OF GEORGIA - PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

ALS United of Georgia has a dedicated Care Services Team whose goal is to meet every individual diagnosed with ALS, and their families, as soon as possible. Our goal is to ensure individuals and families understand their ALS diagnosis and focus on meeting needs that will optimize and enhance their quality of life. Upon registering with ALS United of Georgia, a Care Services Coordinator is personally assigned to you who will assist throughout your journey, answering questions and providing resources to help meet your needs. With this focus in mind, the following programs have been created to positively impact families living with ALS: **The Kostiuk ALS Care Grant Program, Support Groups & Education, The Ricky P. Sweat ALS Equipment Loaner & Assistive Technology Program, The Paul B. Williams Transportation Program, and The Sally Panfel In-Home Care & Respite Program.**

Individuals who are newly diagnosed often need time to absorb the impact of their diagnosis, and basic information and education are immediately provided. This information includes, but is not limited to, the diagnosis itself, the disease trajectory, support, and ongoing research. ALS United of Georgia provides an annual educational Symposium which highlights the research, support and education opportunities to people living with ALS, Community Providers, Caregivers and Supporters. Although to date there is no cure for this disease, we are passionate about the mission of one day finding a treatment and ultimately a cure.

**THE KOSTIUK ALS CARE GRANT PROGRAM:** The financial hardship that families incur as the result of an ALS diagnosis can impact their quality of life tremendously. For those that may need additional help, **The Kostiuk ALS Care Grant Program** strives to provide some relief. This program is a reimbursement program that assists families with expenses that are not traditionally covered by private insurance, Medicaid, or Medicare. It will cover expenses related to home care assistance, travel costs for attendance to and from an ALS Clinic, home modifications, auto modifications, communication devices, and more. Registered families are eligible to apply for the Kostiuk ALS Care Grant Program annually. Award opportunities are based upon funding.

**The Support Group Program** provides individuals with ALS and their families the opportunity to connect with others in the community who share similar challenges and needs. The groups are designed to provide emotional and psychosocial support, as well as resources and education. Knowing what questions to ask and where to look for resources is vital. ALS United of Georgia currently hosts a variety of support groups that meet monthly or quarterly throughout the state of Georgia. These groups are facilitated by professionals and community partners to ensure maximum results.

**THE RICKY P. SWEAT ALS EQUIPMENT LOANER & ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM:** As ALS progresses, individuals will experience a decline in functioning as it relates to mobility and speech. These challenges can impact independence and quality of life. In some situations, specific medical and communication devices are required but not covered by private insurance, Medicaid, or Medicare. **The Ricky P. Sweat ALS Equipment Loaner & Assistive Technology Program** provides such equipment to individuals with ALS, at no cost. This program works diligently to obtain, through grant funding or private donations, such items that can ensure increased independence. ALS United of Georgia, in partnership with community providers, collaborate on the maintenance and storage of all equipment.

**THE SALLY PANFEL ALS IN-HOME CARE AND RESPITE PROGRAM:** 90% of the current ALS community in Georgia continues to remain in their home throughout the disease process. This becomes increasingly difficult for family caregivers because individuals will require total Activities of Daily Living (ADL) care from additional providers. This service is not covered by Medicare or private insurance companies. **The Sally Panfel ALS In-Home Care and Respite Program** provides pALS with up to 18 hours of in-home care per week, for a limited time period while families work to identify longer-term solutions. The care is provided by licensed community partners by ALS United of Georgia and eligibility is based on a needs assessment.

**THE PAUL B. WILLIAMS ALS TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM:** Access to quality care and research can be challenging for those impacted by ALS. As mobility declines, individuals with ALS find it difficult to attend needed appointments, or community events via traditional modes of transportation. Medicare and Medicaid are very limited regarding the coverage of non-emergency transportation. **The Paul B. Williams ALS Transportation Program** is focused on addressing transportation needs via: non-emergency transportation, van rentals, vehicle modification, and vouchers towards the purchase of accessible transportation. An application is required to receive this service.

Information is vital to families living ALS. As the body declines, it is very important to be presented with realistic expectations regarding the disease trajectory. Skilled Care Service Coordinators are available to provide ongoing consultations through our **Care Services Consultation Program**. The ongoing consultations provide the opportunity to assess, educate and empower individuals and their families to make informed decisions. The coordinators are also very instrumental in identifying and making community referrals to help meet the family's needs. ALS United of Georgia is the connection between what is needed and what is available for individuals with ALS, their families, and caregivers.

# Enrolling in the National ALS Registry

## Information to Help You Join the National ALS Registry.

### Who Can Sign Up?

Any adult with ALS in the United States can join the National ALS Registry. If you have a related disease, such as PLS, PMA, or PBP, you will not be able to register at this time.

### Will My Information Be Private?

Yes, all information collected by the National ALS Registry is confidential and not shared with anyone.

### What Do I Need to Enroll?

- **A computer or device (e.g., tablet or phone) with internet access**
  - What if I don't have access to a computer?
    - You can ask a family member, caregiver, or friend to borrow their computer.
    - You can contact your ALS advocacy organization, and someone can help you through the process.
- **An email address**
- **Social security number (the last 5 digits only)**
  - Please note, your information is never shared with anyone.
- **Although not necessary, it can be helpful to enroll with a caregiver or family member to help.**

### How Much Time Do I Need to Enroll?

**Enrolling in the Registry is a quick process, and it usually takes about 5-10 minutes.** You may have heard about the Registry's risk factor surveys. Your progress will be saved, and you can come back to explore other parts of the Registry.
